NATIONAL RIFLE ASSOCIATION (NRA) OPENING DINNER THREATENED TO BE SHUT DOWN, WITH FORCE, FROM HIS MAJESTY'S BRITISH TROOPS. TERRORISTS, LOCALS AND REBELS WARNED ABOUT SECRET MEETINGS.

DEEMED AN ILLEGAL ASSEMBLY

(Charlotte, NC) May 10, 2010 – On the 230th anniversary year of the famed, local battle of King's Mountain - comes the annual NRA convention. A kickoff dinner will get things started for the Charlotte Metrolina area on Thursday May 13, 2010 at 6 pm in Lifepointe Community Center, 2266 Deerfield Drive, Fort Mill, SC almost 600 attendees will join for the banquet. Local British rule under Lord General Cornwallis has stated they will seize all and any weapons held by terrorists, locals, and rebels.

British troops operated in the area during 1780 since the fall of Charleston, the invasion of the South taking Savannah and impending invasion of the Charlotte region. The large battle of Camden, SC will turn into a disastrous defeat for the Americans and sink the war effort to all new lows. Recently the English have fortified Fort 96 (in Western South Carolina) and appointed Major Patrick Ferguson to humble all rebels.

The South Carolina Friends of the NRA and the Metro Carolina Friends of the NRA are hosting the Kick-Off dinner. SC State Representative Mike Pitts is the honorary chairman. The 2010 NRA Annual Meeting starts on Friday May 14 going through Sunday May 16, 2010. Media opportunities are available via filming and interviews for all media and encouraged for news crews.

The British authorities have clearly stated from Lord Cornwallis personal headquarters, "...if we need to roll a cannon into that arena and seize the stage we will. All weapons will be confiscated by armed soldiers of his Majesty's Royal Crown forces. If horses are needed to storm onto the stage, or onto the dinner tables, then armed Troopers will come into the banquet on steeds. No assembly will be tolerated by the secret meeting planners, or terrorists, who illegally bear arms against the rightful ruling government of this country. Loyalists may keep arms in their homes, only."

The American Revolutionary War Living History Center (ARWLHC) is supporting this event with actors and weaponry. The ARWLHC is a newly proposed theme park, attraction and resort (www.arwlhc.com) headquartered at The Inn of the Patriots – located just outside of Kings Mountain National Military Park. It has become a disabled veterans success story, orchestrates large battles and was named the best Inn Worldwide to Visit for History in 2009 and 2010 - by BedandBreakfast.com

The Royal North Carolina Regiment (RNCR) is supporting this event with actors and weaponry. The RNCR (www.rncr.org) is an operating unit that hosts numerous historical events each year and is most famous for it's appearances as British soldiers and artillery crews. The level of expertise and authentic portrayals that they bring to events is stunning.

The Metro Carolina Friends of the NRA (MCFNRA), chartered in 2006 as part of the SC Friends of the NRA, hosts an annual fund raising event in York County, SC. These events raise money for the NRA Foundation, which is the non-profit side of the NRA devoted to teach safe firearms ownership. The program is structured so that half of the money raised returns to the state (where raised) to fund grant requests submitted by shooting, education, & law enforcement organizations in South Carolina. MCFNRA holds their banquet on the second Thursday in May, annually.
